<b>Sound of the alarm</b>
The sound of the alarm will be: A continuous fire alarm throughout the building

<b>Raising the alarm</b>
In the event of a fire beginning  If the fire is discovered by a staff member or a visitor notifies a staff member of a fire, the alarm will be raised by: activation of the nearest call point, or commencing manual warning (ie. shout).

<b>Action staff should take on hearing the alarm</b>
The following actions will be taken upon the fire alarm being sounded/raised: (modify/delete as applicable to your site) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Leave the building by the nearest fire exit.</li> <li>Assist anyone who needs help to leave.</li> <li>Close all doors behind you.</li> <li>Do not stop to collect personal belongings.</li> <li>Report to the Assembly Point which is located adjacent to the bins at the main gate.</li> <li>Do not re-enter the building until authorised to do so.</li> <li>Group Leader is to ensure that all group members are clear of the building by use of fire register.</li> <li>Group leader is to liaise with Fire Service in the first instance.</li> <li>Inform the Site Manager of the incident on 07466402285.</li> </ul>

<b>Escape routes</b>
The escape routes from the building are: (detail designated fire escape routes) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Activity/Dining Area – exit through activity hall fire exit, opposite the kitchen area, taking you onto the car park. From here, individuals should make their way to the front of the building and to the fire assembly point, as detailed below.</li> <li>2. Bedrooms – exit through either the boot room side exit, or the corridor fire exit.</li> </ol>

<b>Fire assembly point</b>
The assembly point is: Adjacent to the bins, by the main gate to the car park.

<b>Fighting fires – Extinguisher use</b>
Fire extinguishers will only be used where: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The individual feels confident and is competent in their use</li> <li>Where it is deemed safe to do so i.e. there is a clear means of escape, fire is small</li> </ul> <p><b>Personal safety always takes priority and, if in any doubt, individuals should not attempt to extinguish a fire</b></p>

**Location of key safety hazards or other fire related equipment**

- Gas supply shut off: n/a
- Mains fuse box: boot room/ corridor
- Mains water inlet: cleaning cupboard
- Gas/oxygen cylinders: N/A
- Fire extinguishers: activity area, entrance hall, corridor
